



Fragrant rice cooked with coconut milk and pandan (screw pine) leaf, served with spicy condiment called sambal, fried anchovies (ikan bilis), peanut and hard boiled egg, is a staple for many Malaysians for breakfast. This becomes a platform for many different potential combinations. It can be served with rendang daging, fried chicken, sambal squid and many more You are only bounded by your own imagination

# Char Kueg Teow

Flat rice noodle stir-fried over a hot wok with high heat imparts the firey or smoky taste, or called wok hei' to the dish. This dish has many combinations which can be found all over Malaysia, and even Singapore. Penang has a version which has fresh seafood added into it which is known throughout the world. Simple and hearty, this quick dish is easily dished out within minutes.

Iconic flat bread served with curry or dal is a simple yet hearty meal, especially breakfast for many. Served by mamaks, it is available from

breakfast to supper. Due to the diverse possibilities of the roti canai, it has spun many different varieties of roti canai which one can enjoy. From the savoury meat filled roti canai to the sweet roti milo, covered in Milo powder, to fruit filled roti banana or roti durian, there are endless possibility.



many varieties, from the sour, fishy and spicy Penang Asam laksa, Sarawak laksa in the soup-base of sambal belacan, to the thick broth coconut broth spicy curry laksa and many more in between with their own unique twist.

# Chicken Rice

The commonly known chicken rice hails all the way from Hainan which was brought when Chinese immigrants moved to Malaysia. The fragrant 'oily rice' is served with poached chicken, with slices of fresh cucumber and homemade chilli sauce. Variants of this dish are also available, with the poached chicken replaced with fried chicken or even roasted chicken. In Malacca, there is a novelty special, known as chicken rice ball where the rice are rolled into balls and have a stickier and more chewier texture.

Acronym for Ais Batu lampur, this cold dessert has many ingredients in a small bowl, usually sweet, topped with finely shaved ice and drenched in condensed milk, or coconut milk, whichever preferred. At certain region, even palm sugar is an additional option to add to

Rojak








# The Duo Celebrations

### The Ring Lady

There are only three ring ladies left in the world from Kampung Semban (the village above the clouds) tucked in the mountains between Sarawak (Malaysia) and Kalimantan (Indonesia). They started wearing the ring at the age between 9 – 10 years old. The copper rings were a sign of beauty and prestige in their village, while the other purpose of wearing the rings is for protection from harm or unexpected injury.

### Ngajat

The ngajat performed by male Iban warriors to celebrate their return from battles since the 16th Century. It depicts of them stalking and attacking their prey, wielding a sword and a shield, incorporating leaps and howls. Nowadays, the dance is performed by both men and women during the Gawai celebration. Apart from that, it is also performed during special occasions and to welcome important guests.

horizontally above the ground at ankle height. Clapping each other to a low-tempo drumbeat, dancers are required to jump over or between the poles without getting their feet caught according to the tempo. To up the excitement, the tempo and speed of clapping bamboo poles will be increasingly faster and the dancers follow suit. This requires great agility to perform.

### Perotong

The Pratuokng/ Perutong
(Bidayuh Bamboo Zither) is a
Bidayuh traditional instrument
made from bamboo. It tuned like
gong set which can also be used to
replace the gong in old days when
a full assemble is not present.

### Sape

A traditional string instrument of the Orang Ulu community. Sape is a boat-shaped woodcarving masterpiece with colourful motifs, carved from a single bole of selected fine grain wood. The idea of Sape was from a farmer who dreamt of the sound of Sape would attract the spirit to come and cure his wifes sickness. In the past, the Sape was played solely during healing ceremonies, but today has become a social instrument which is used as a form of entertainment.

### Malay Tradilional Dance

Joget is the most popular traditional dance in Malaysia which has origins in Portuguese folk dance. Performed by pairs of couples, accompany with upbeat tempo dance together with fast and graceful movements, it showcases a playful humour in the dance itself


