Sarawak Day

This day is celebrated as a recognition when the state of Sarawak established its own self-governance as it gained independence from the British colony on 22 July 1963, with Datuk Stephen Kalong Ningkan being appointed as the first Chief Minister before joining the Federation of Malaya with North Borneo (now known as Sabah) and Singapore on 16 September 1963 to form the Federation of Malaysia. Sarawak Day was gazetted as a public holiday in 2016 by the 5th Chief Minister, the late Yang Amat Berhormat Datuk Patinggi Tan Sri (Dr) Haji Adenan Bin Haji Satem, to raise awareness as well as celebrating the history of Sarawak and the struggles and achievements of past leaders.

When the last of the Brookes ceded Sarawak to the crown colony in 1 July 1946. This received major protest from local Sarawakians whom requested independence to be restored, leading to the assassination of Sarawak's Governor Duncan Stewart by Rosli Dhobi, whom was captured and convicted for murder. The sentiment for independence grew stronger. On 22 July 1963, the last Governor of the Colony, Sir Alexander Waddell issued a proclamation to form the first Supreme Council with the appointment of Stephen Kalong Ningkan, as the first Chief Minister of Sarawak.

Merdeka Day

Merdeka Day, falling on 31 August, marks the day the Federation of Malaya gained independence sovereign from the British Empire. Celebrated throughout Malaysia, it marks the eleven states of Peninsular Malaysia (known as the Malay State formerly) came together to form the federation.

On August 31, 1957, the Federation of Malaya achieved independence as promised by the British, headed by the first Prime Minister, Tunku Abdul Rahman whom led a delegation to London to seek independence from the British Empire. The Reid Commission was established in 1956 and The Treaty of London 1956 was signed which led to the Federation of Malaya Independence Act 1957 giving independence sovereign as well as becoming a member of the Commonwealth of Nations on 31 August 1957.

Malaysia Day

Celebrated as the day when the Federation of Malaya, Singapore, Sarawak and Sabah (formerly North Borneo) federated on 16 September 1963. Initially planned to coincide with Hari Merdeka, due to unrest happening in Indonesia and Philippines. This is also due to the setting up of the Cobbold Commission to look into, report the support from North Borneo (known now as Sabah) and Sarawak and determine on the formation.

Initially only celebrated in Sabah and Sarawak before 2009, it was declared as a national holiday by the Prime Minister in 2010 to commemorate on the formation of Malaysia as well as to remember the sacrifice and hardship faced by our forefathers of the nation as well as celebrating the achievement which was achieved without any bloodshed but through negotiation and talks.



On the stroke of midnight on 30 August 1957, the Union Flag was lowered at Padang Merdeka and the Flag of Malaya was raised with the playing of national anthem, 'Negaraku'. Tunku Abdul Rahman lead the cheer of independence; "Merdeka" which was chanted seven times with the crowd which attended. This was the day the Federation of Malaya declared independence, hence the name Merdeka Day. The celebration of Merdeka Day was kicked off with Proclamation of Independence being read at the new Stadium Merdeka which was built specifically for this, and attended by members of Royal families from Thailand, Japan and British, rulers from Malaya states, foreign dignitaries, member of the cabinet as well as the citizens. The Federation of Malaya has gained independence and no longer ruled by the British Empire.

PORTUGAL

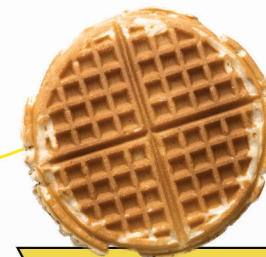
